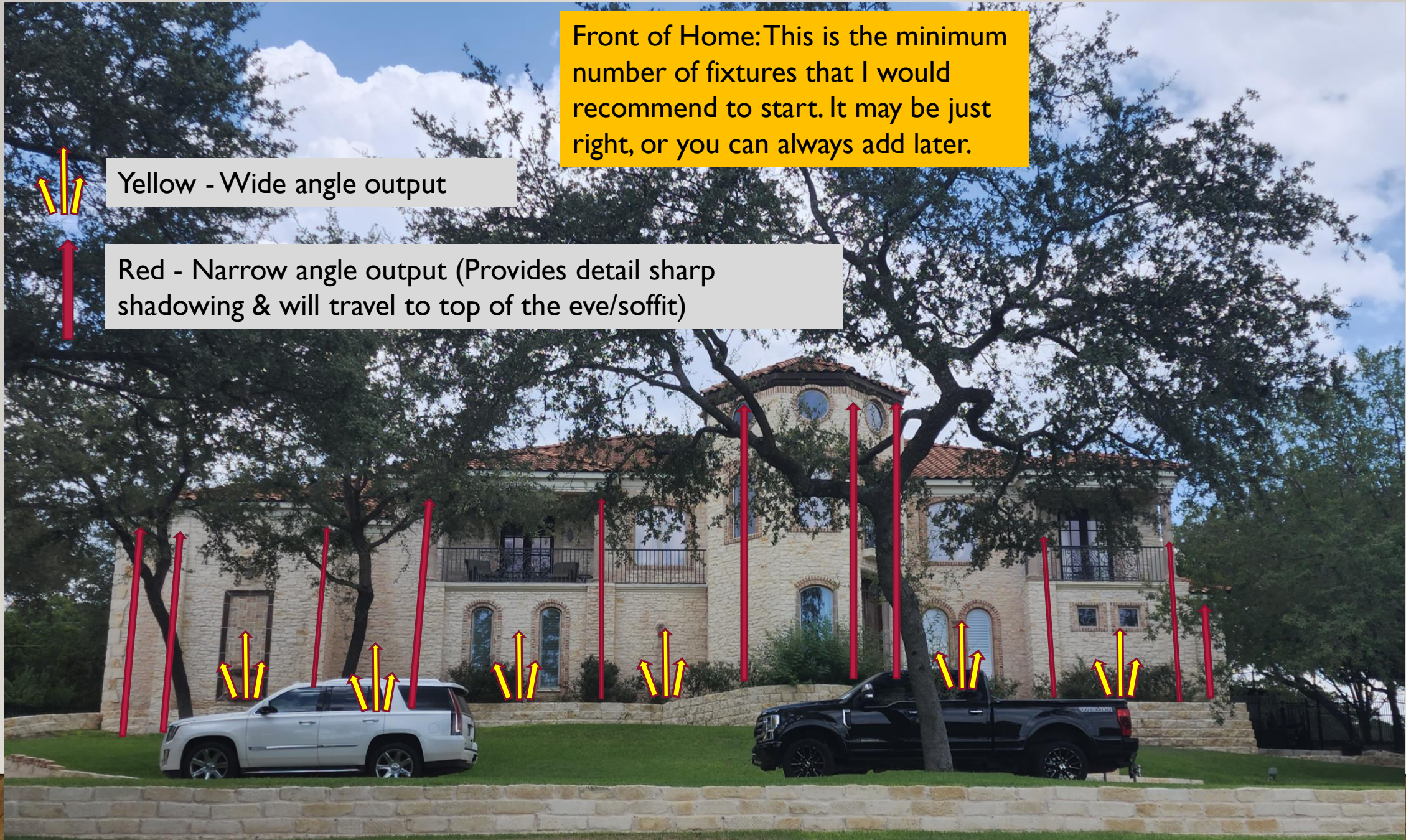


Front of Home: This is the minimum number of fixtures that I would recommend to start. It may be just right, or you can always add later.

Yellow - Wide angle output

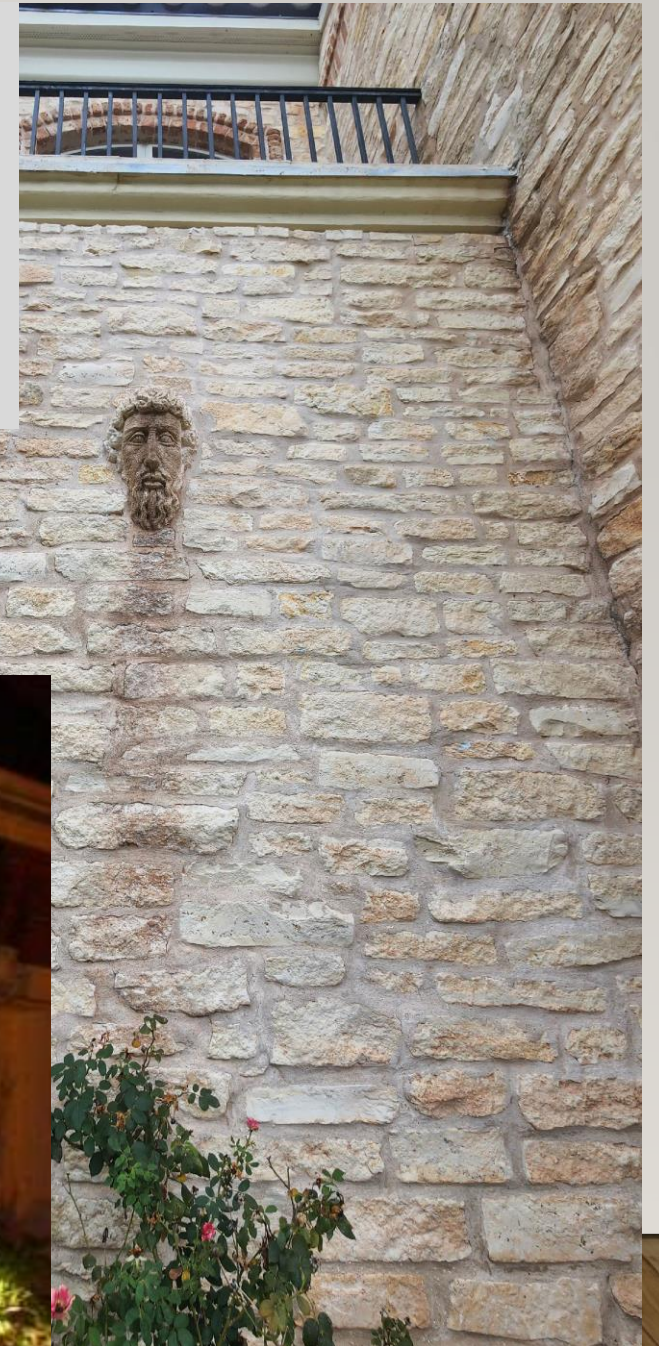
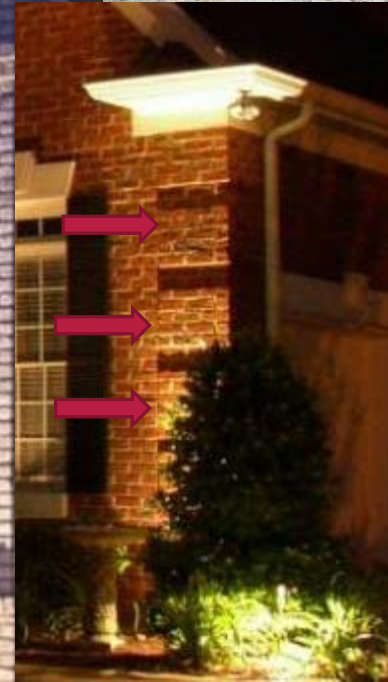
Red - Narrow angle output (Provides detail sharp shadowing & will travel to top of the eve/soffit)



Question:

Is there parts of the architecture that you do not want to highlight?

EG Stone protrusions on the corners. In the example to the left. I like the shadowing for texture, depth, and detail it provides that is not as noticeable during the day. You may not.



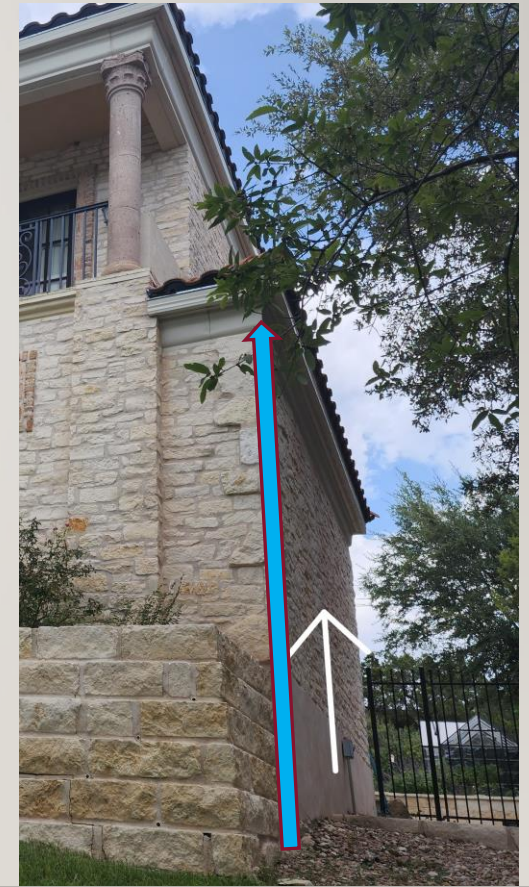
Places for growth/expansion – The front of the home is a great example of where you can start with a modest number and decide later if you would like more depth, detail, kelvin, and wattage/lumens. You should also keep in mind who or what is inside the windows that we illuminate outside of. This might dictate where and what type of lights and type can be installed. * This page shows more. 12 fixtures total. Arrows duplicate the same fixtures

8 Up lights - 1 Wall Washer – 4 Well Lights the raised be wall & side wall

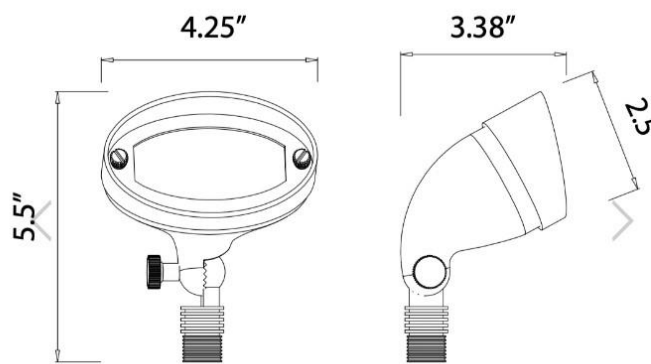


Places for growth/expansion – * This page shows Less. 7 Fixtures for this section

The [blue](#) arrow in the right pic on right corner is an example of “*splitting the corner*”. This can be a great way to knock out two birds with one stone. Reduce the number of fixtures or it may be a matter of less light is more. It will provide front and side of the corner with lighting and may put less emphasis on the protruding stone if you are not a fan.

Premium Options

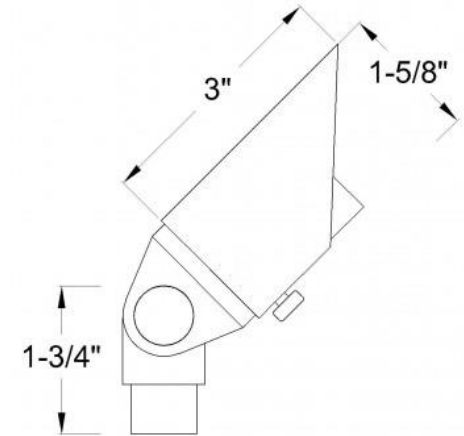
Right: This is an almost commercial grade fixture that I do recommend when positioned closer to driveways. It is the same manufacture of the really heavy fixtues that I showed you.

Left: This is a very durable fixture from Garden Light LED based in Tampa FL. This is the company that has a number of unique and compact fixtures.



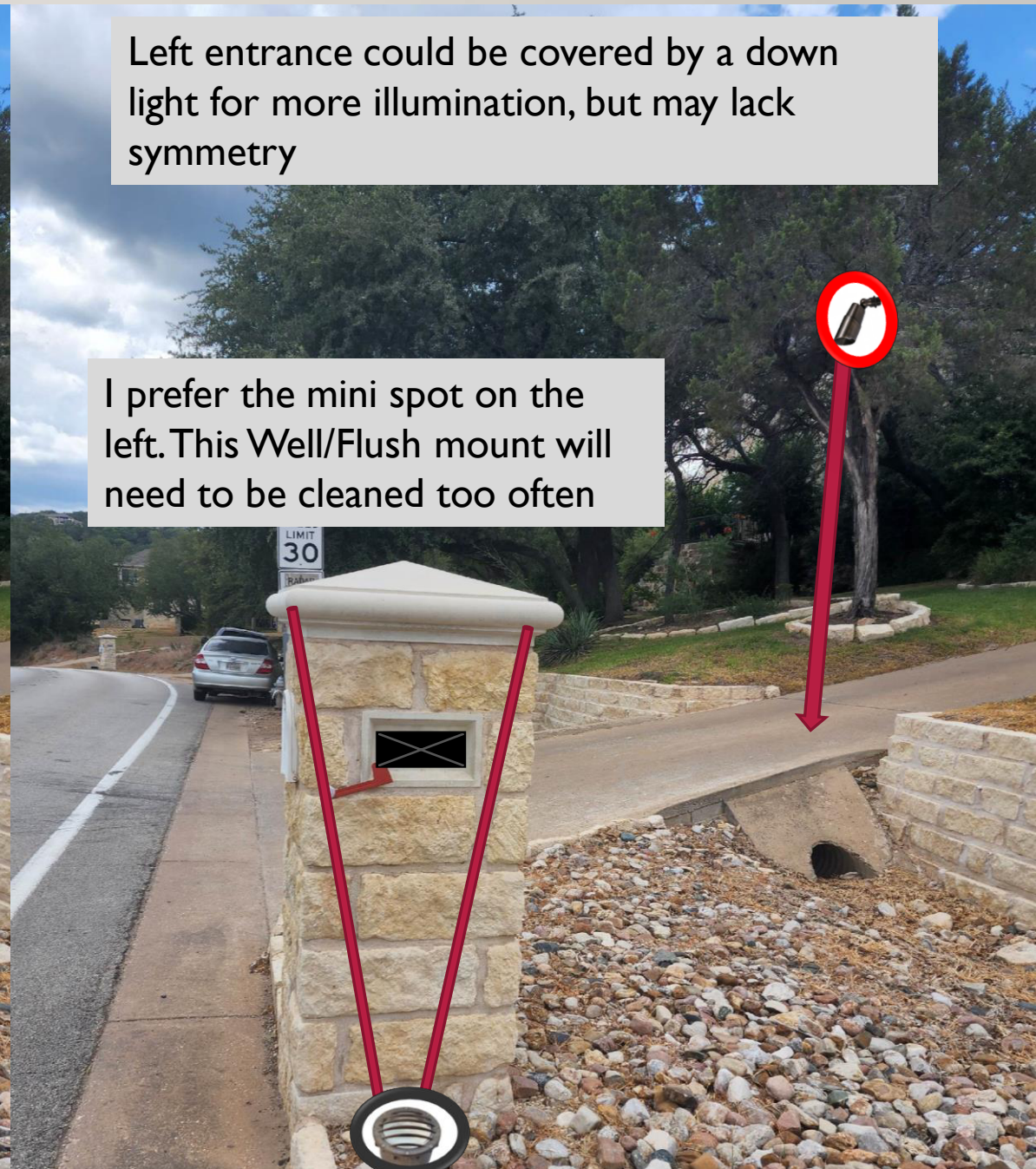

Left entrance could be covered by a down light for more illumination, but may lack symmetry

I prefer the mini spot on the left. This Well/Flush mount will need to be cleaned too often
